OSteer Committee Rate Structuring

Current rate structures weren't working for T3 lines

Some users were subsidizing other users

Two options:

A. Tiered service with capped bandwidth at the router

B. Burstable service - paying for what you use monthly

Measuring would occur using the 5 minute average,
throwing out the top 5 samples and counting the 6th
sample as the average

Rate Structures were developed looking at other ISP's

Burst Service will be twice the rate of Tiered service

Costs will be announced by OARnet

Internet2 schools will see no change by this model

Student Tools; Homepage, Grades, Calendar, Manual, Announcements

Threaded discussion groups and real-time chats and white boards

Faculty can setup mailing lists and groups (mini-listserves)

Audio/Video, Spreadsheets, Search Engines, Surveys, Testing,

Data Measurement

Students can track their own grades - System can auto-grade tests with immediate feedback and lockout the retries.
