A federated system of authentication that makes it possible for students and faculty to access resources at multiple campuses through a single account.”

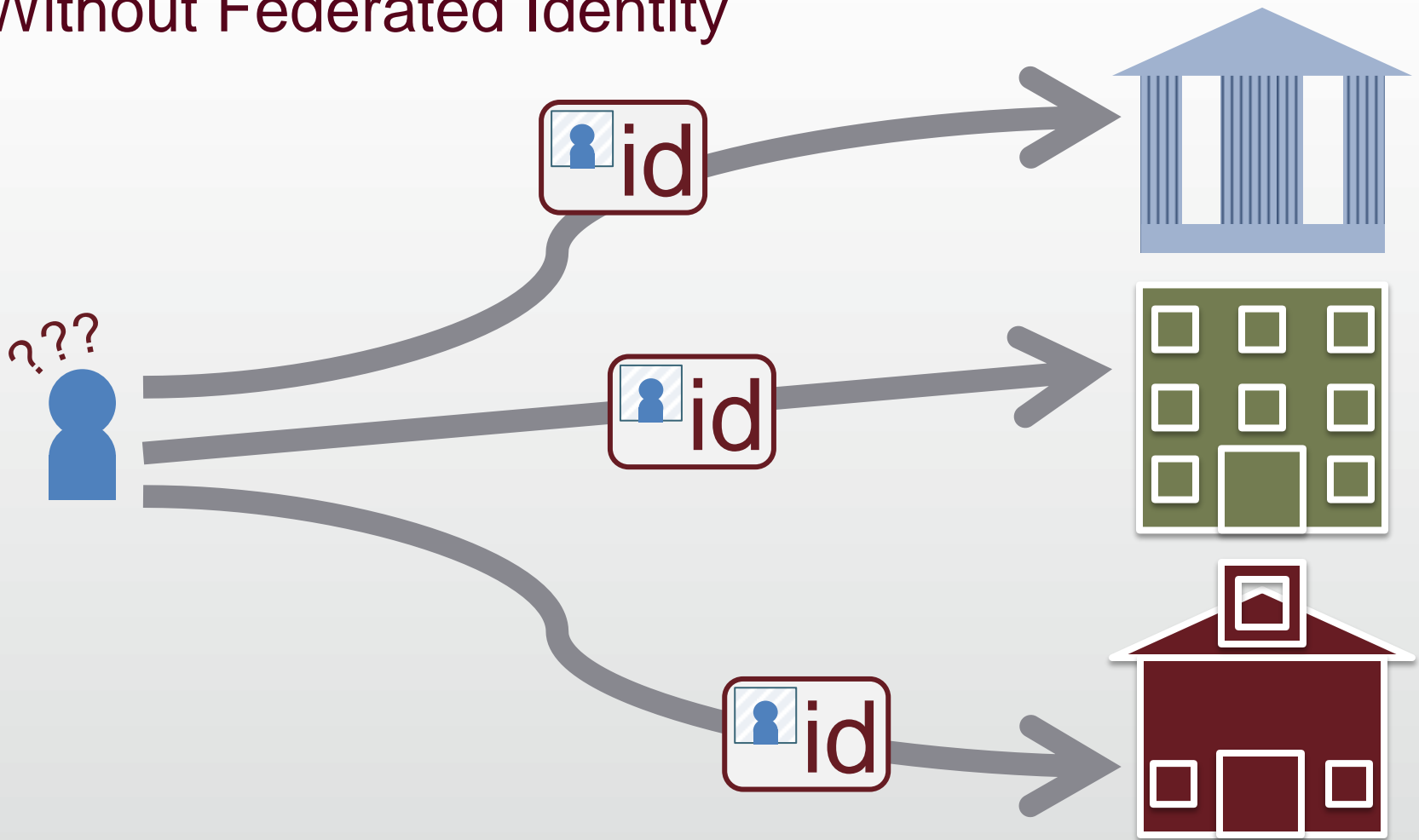
What is Federated Identity?

Your academic login becomes a single – trusted – online – passport to education, research, and collaboration opportunities throughout Ohio.

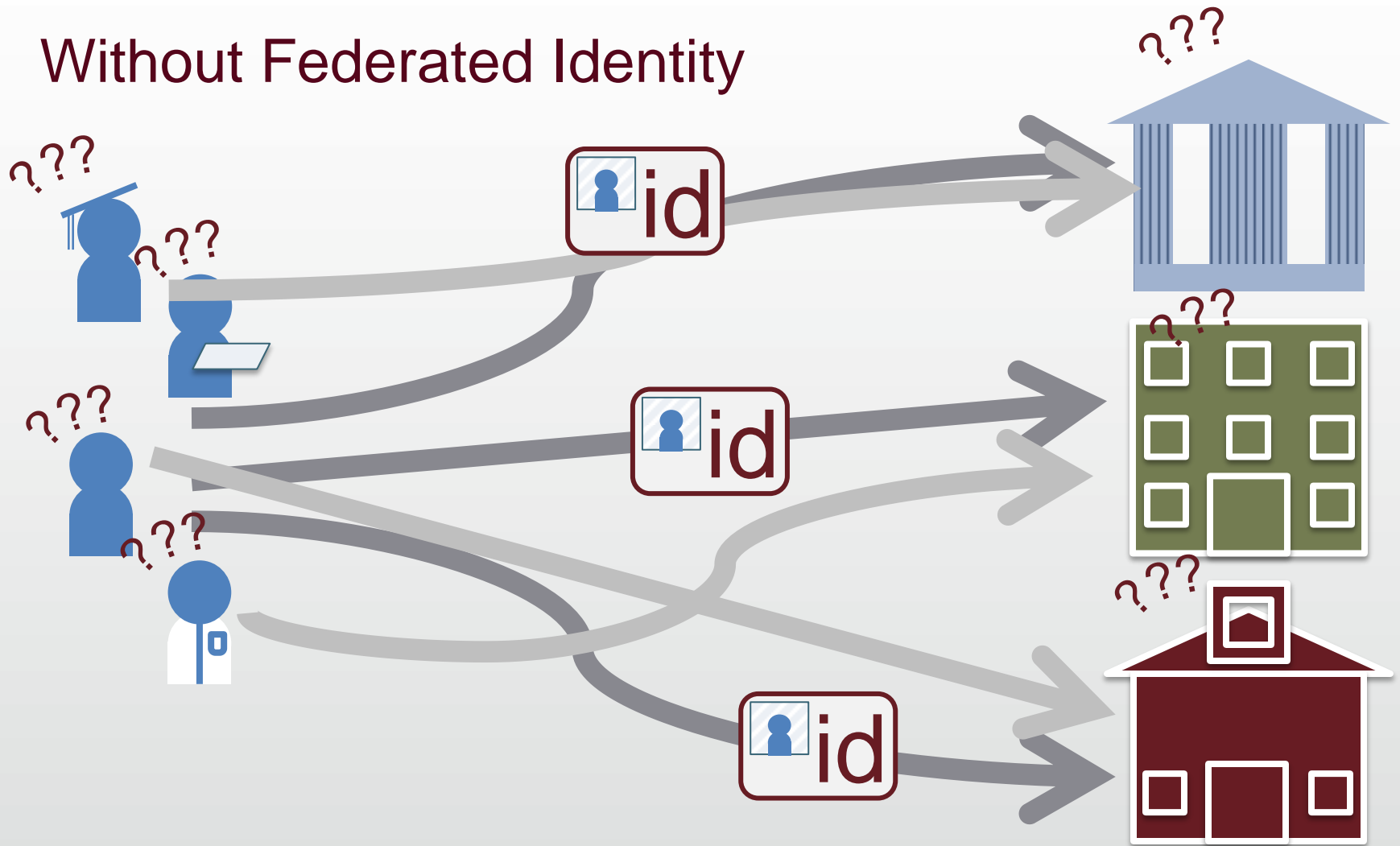
What does it mean to **you**?

- ✓ *passport accepted everywhere*

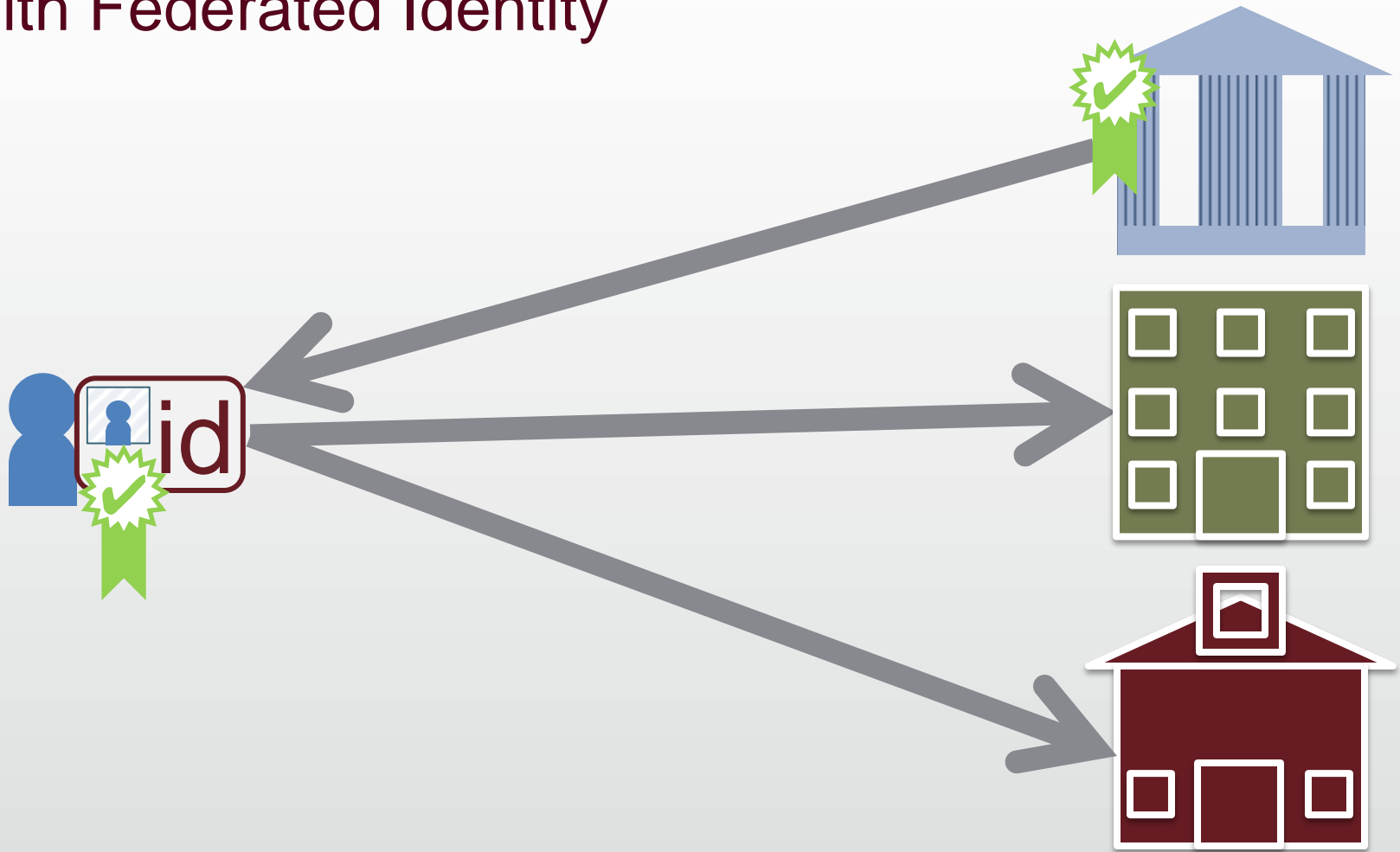

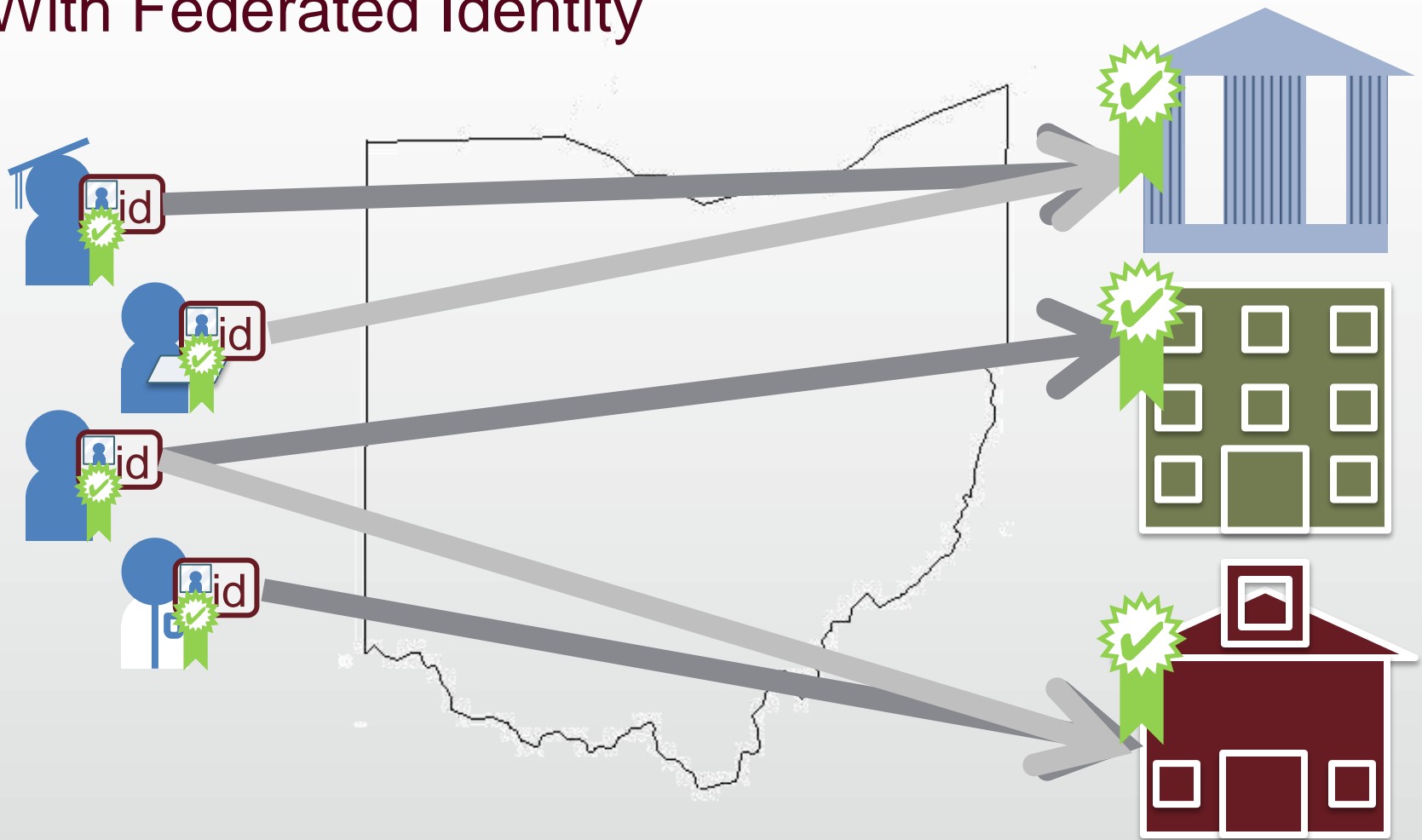

What problems are we trying to solve?

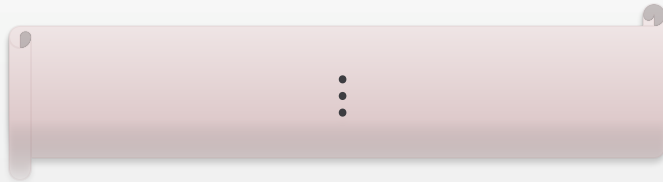
- Multiple logins, multiple passwords
- Lack of access to applications and services
- Privacy breaches
- Lack of trust in identity and privacy claims
- Disconnected silos of information
- Duplicated effort and expense

Benefits

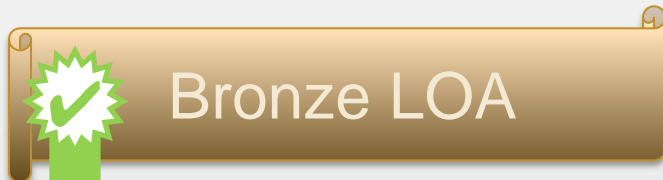
- Single ID for a single user
- Standard way to access applications and services
- Less opportunity to breach identity data
- Individual control of identity and trust
- Connected fabric of services
- Reduce duplication, support costs

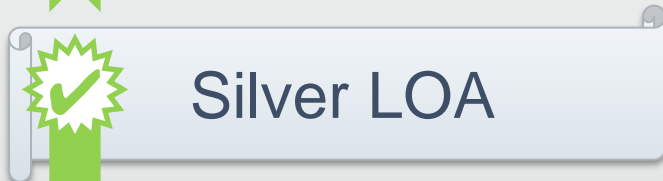
- Federation operator defines Levels of Assurance



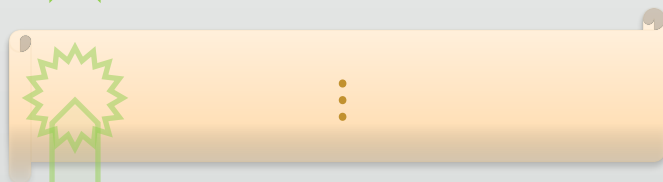

- + Audit



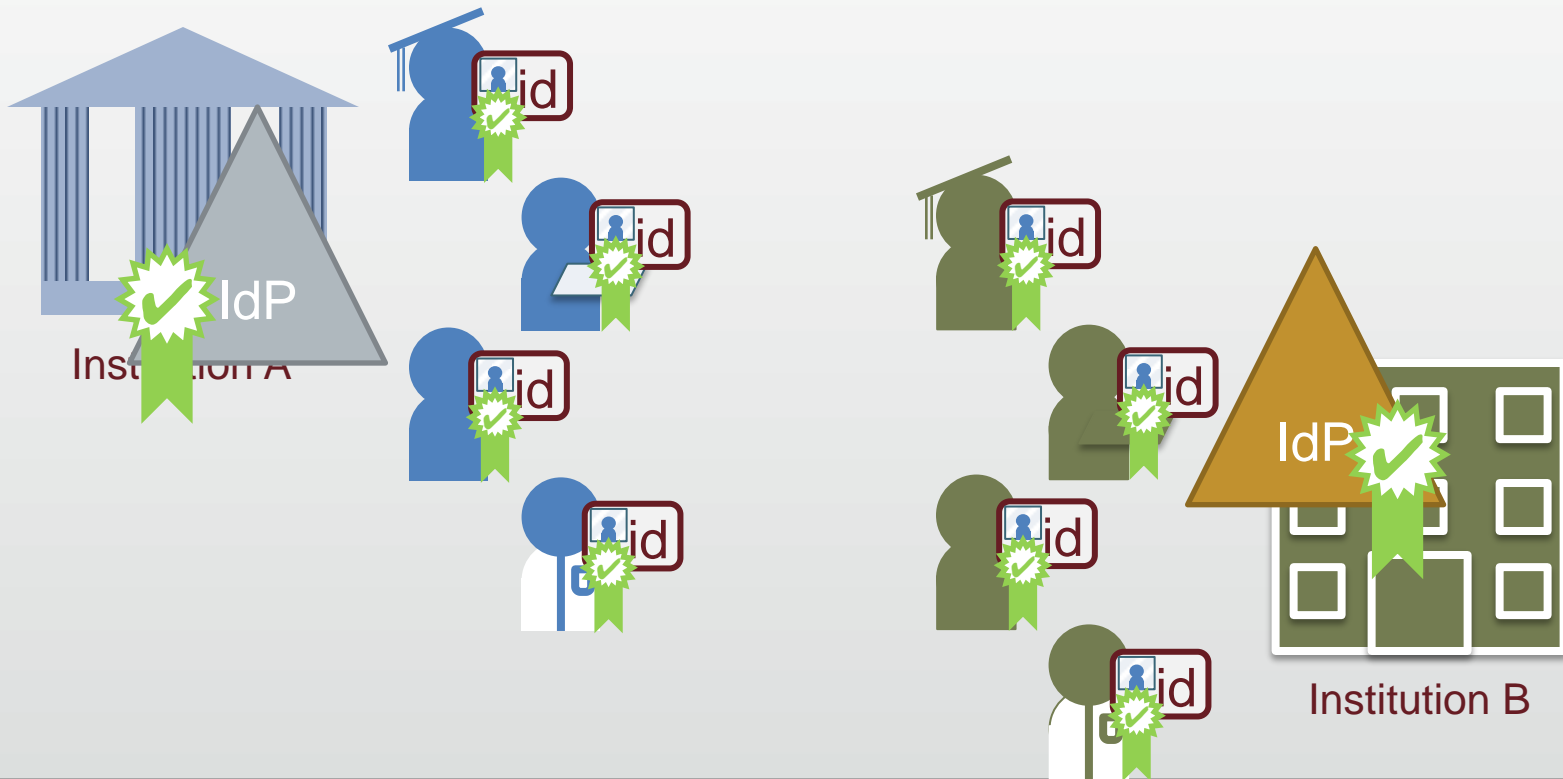
- + Identity proofing

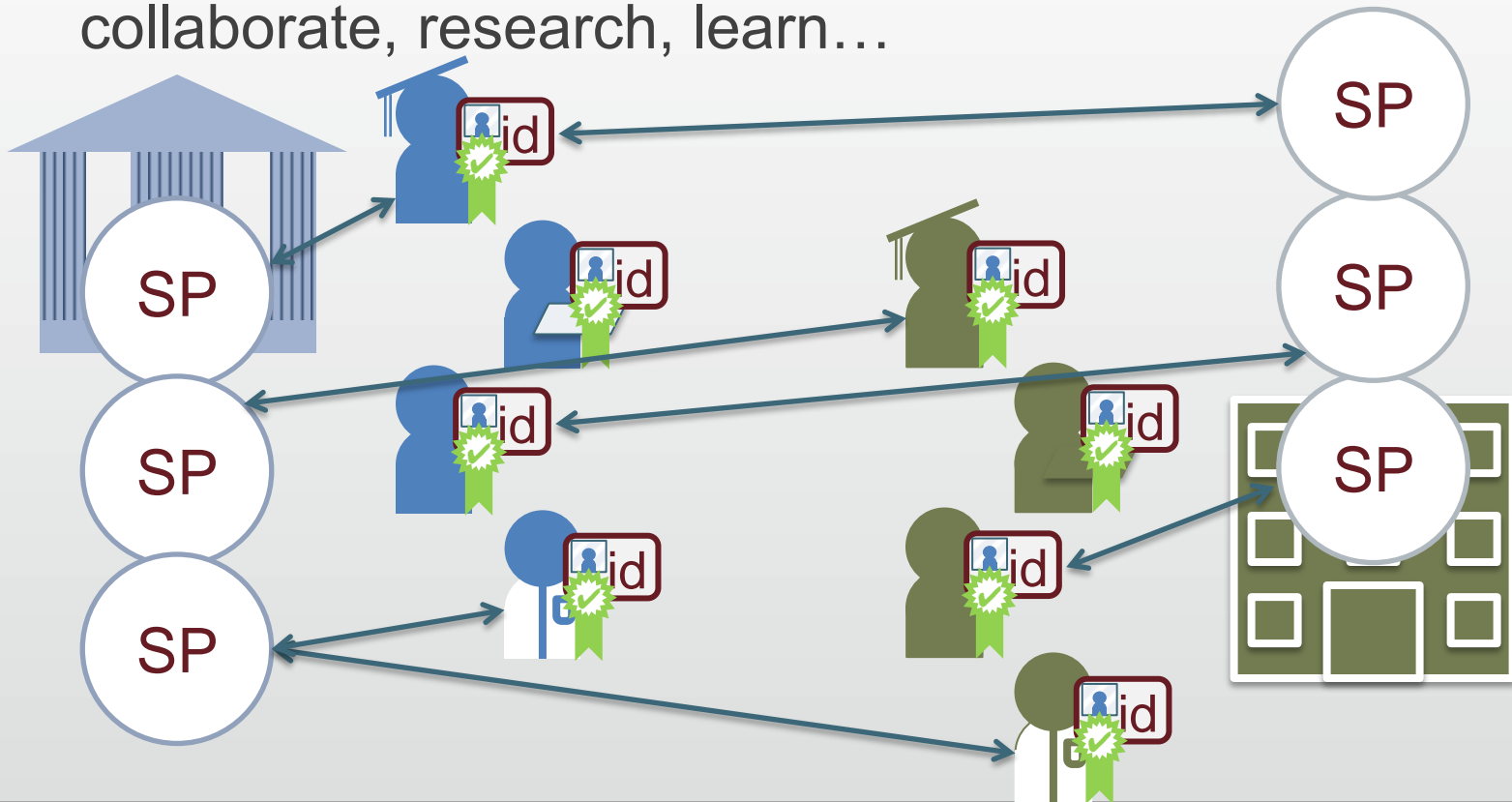
How it works - 2

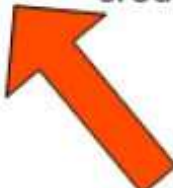
